Introduction

Symbol USBDownload is a PC application which allows you to download .hex files from a PC to a supported Symbol mobile computer via a USB connection. Normally when changing the Operating System (OS) on a Symbol mobile computer the recommendation is to use OSUpdate, UpdateLoader, AirBeam or MSP. However in cases where the OS may not be functional, or for purposes of disaster recovery where these tools cannot be used, USBDownload may be used to reload or change the OS on supported mobile computers.
